I teach both courses concurrently during the fall, winter, and two summer terms (i.e., eight courses total per year). Lectures and tutorials are uploaded to the online forum, Avenue to Learn. Students watch the lectures and tutorials, and send me weekly assignments. I grade each assignment and send them back with comments and corrections. I schedule meetings with students, in person if they are close enough, via Skype, or by phone, to discuss their progress and to answer any questions they may have with the material. I also administer exams for students who are close, or arrange for a proctor for students not in the immediate area.
